- 7 Canadian based companies: potential new CGEF members

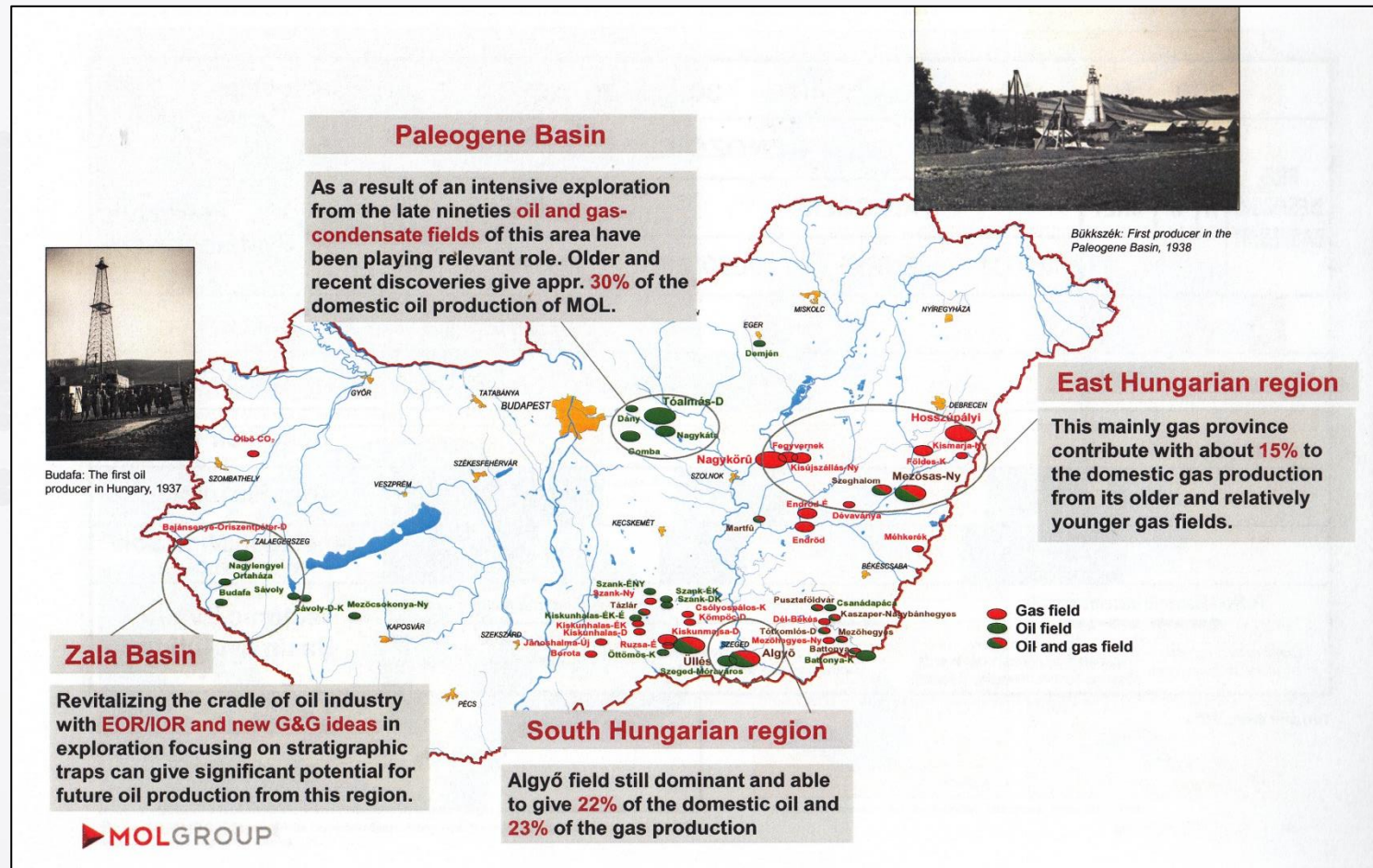

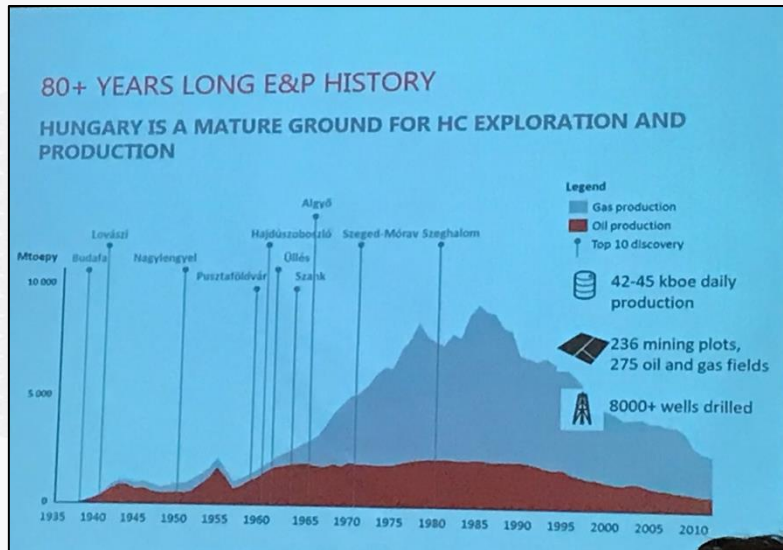

- Upcoming bid rounds in 6 countries; Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Hungary, Lithuania, Montenegro, & Poland.



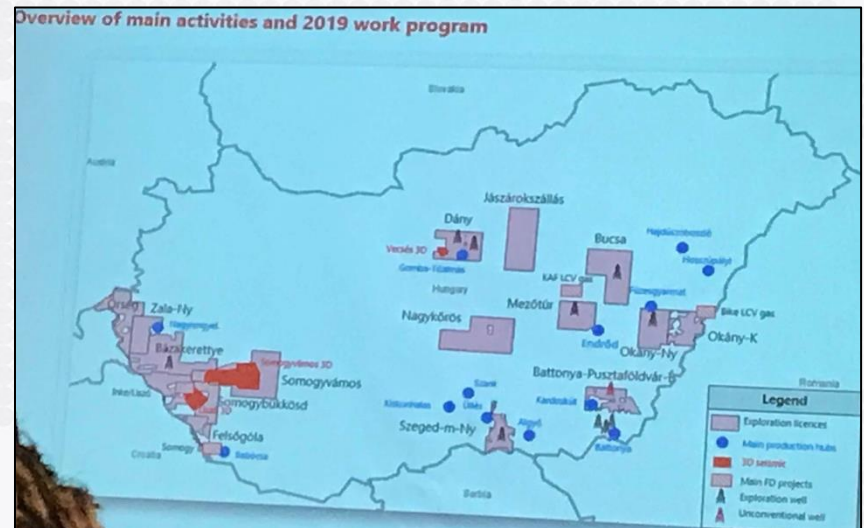
# Hungary – Hydrocarbon Regions

Declining oil & gas production



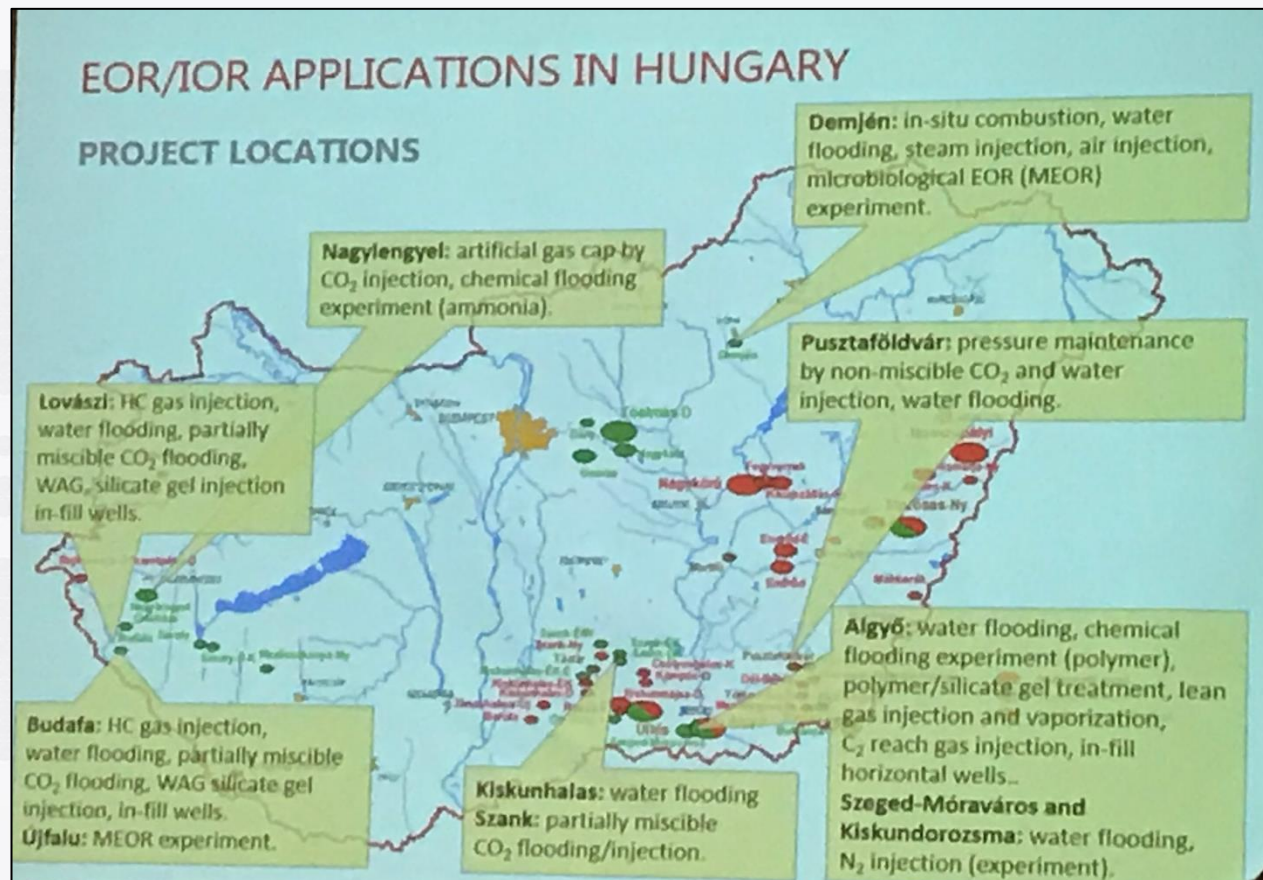
